4 simple ways to be AWESOME!

1) Be an Awesome Member to our Neighbors

One of the key ingredients to being an awesome MIBC member is to be good to our neighbors. Here is one easy way...**Drive very carefully and slowly on Avalon Drive.** The streets are narrow and there are numerous blind driveways with tons of kids playing and people walking their dogs.

To achieve this good member status, please do the following:

- **Drive 15 mph or less on Avalon** (driving faster only "saves" about 1.5 seconds of time between MIBC and E. Mercer Way); **GO SLOW signs have been placed along Avalon Drive as a reminder to all**
- No texting, ever
- Drive even slower if you see people on the streets
- It's ok to be a little late to the Beach Club...we are not going anywhere :)
- When parking on the main street, please respect the "no parking" signs.

2) Be a Great Pool Parent

- No glass on the pool deck (even pouring). It can destroy the liner to our pool and be a mess to clean up.
- **Register your guests at check in - help explain the pool rules**
- Make sure your kids are wearing coastguard-approved life jackets as opposed to water wings or other safety flotation devices (check the tags when you buy it).
- No floaties in the pool. They seriously inhibit the lifeguard's ability to see.
- If your child cannot swim you must be in the pool with your child within arm's reach.
- No squirt guns in the pool area. They encourage running on the pool deck.
- If you need to converse with a lifeguard keep it brief. They're not allowed to look away from the pool while on the stand so don't be offended when they don't make eye contact.
- No launching kids in the pool.
- No assisted diving board jumps (your child must be able to swim to the wall on their own).
- If you have a serious issue that needs to be discussed please bring it up to a Head Life Guard or the General Manager.

3) Beach Club Grounds

- **No pets allowed on Beach Club property PLEASE.**
- **No Smoking allowed on Beach Club property PLEASE.**
- Clean up and throw out trash - helps keep the crows away.
- All bonfires need to be set up and lit by club staff.
- All BBQ and ground parties need to be done by 10pm.
- Please do not pour grease down the BBQ sink (instead pour it into a sealable container and dispose of it into the regular garbage).
- No swimming off the day dock or moorage areas.
- Help mentor new members with club policies.
