

Mercer Island Beach Club Guest Policy

Mercer Island Beach Club (MIBC or Club) is a private club that exists for the pleasure, recreation and enjoyment of its members. Guests of members are welcome, subject to guest policies and applicable fees, and must be accompanied by the hosting member while using the Club facilities.

General Guest Rules

- Members and junior members 16 years of age or older may host recreational or social guests. Junior members under the age of 16 may not host guests.
- Guests must be accompanied by the hosting member or junior member at all times while on the Club premises, excluding areas of the Club segregated by gender, such as locker rooms, or as otherwise provided in this Policy.
- Guests must comply with all rules, policies and procedures of general application established by the Club, including the MIBC Code of Conduct.
- Members who are delinquent in the payment of Club dues or fees of any kind may not host guests, and any former guest expelled from MIBC premises for any reason may not be allowed back as a guest.
- Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests and all charges and fees resulting from their guests' Club use. Members may be disciplined for infraction of guest policies or violations of Club policies and procedures by their guests. Such discipline shall include a forfeiture of their ability to host guests for the remainder of that year.

Recreational Guests

Nonmembers who live within a ten (10) mile radius of the Club may only be sponsored as recreational guests once in any consecutive three-month period. This restriction applies to the guest even if sponsored by different members. A recreational guest fee of \$5/day is charged for each guest older than five (5) years of age using areas considered to be recreational or athletic facilities, including locker rooms, pool, beach, courts and fitness room. Members must sign in pool or fitness area guests using the registers located in the lower lobby of the Clubhouse. For other uses (beach, courts) the Member must contact the Club management office.

Members hosting a guest for a tennis, swim or fitness class should contact the class instructor ahead of time to get permission to bring the guest, due to potential class size limitations and staffing needs.

Social Guests

Members may introduce a reasonable number of guests to dine with them in the Club's picnic area or join them for social events.

There is no fee for social guests. A reasonable number of social guests is approximately eight (8) people. Members wishing to bring in larger parties, particularly during periods of heavy use of Club facilities by other members, should contact the Club manager at least 24-hours prior to the time of intended use to determine if a larger number of guests can be accommodated, with the decision of the Club manager to be final and binding.

Boat Guests

Members who have paid moorage fees may sponsor guests to use and join them on their boat. There is no fee for boat guests, but the sponsoring member must either accompany the guest(s) to the boat or should contact the general manager to introduce the guest(s) if the guest(s) will be accessing the boat unaccompanied by the member.

Guest Parking

The parking spaces in the Club premises are reserved exclusively for members. Guests should park their cars along Avalon Drive in a non-obstructive manner that does not restrict homeowner ingress/egress and in compliance with "no parking" and other signage. Guests are allowed to park in the Club parking area only by exception, and only during periods of light use by members, for example, early morning and off-season mid-day and evenings. Cars using the Club facilities must display in an easily visible location a current, valid Club parking sticker. Club personnel will periodically monitor the parking area, particularly during periods of heavy use, and cars with invalid, expired or missing parking stickers are subject to removal and impoundment by commercial towing services at the car owner's sole risk and expense.
