

2020 MIBC PADDLEBOARD CAMP GUIDELINES

7.30.2020

BEFORE ARRIVAL & DROP OFF

Protect against infections:

- Stay at home if your child(ren) are sick.
- DO NOT ENTER if your child(ren) has been diagnosed with COVID 19 (have not recovered or are still within the 14 day quarantine), had symptoms of COVID 19 (within the last 24 hours), or had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID 19 (within the last 24hrs).
- Parents/guardians must sign the MIBC Minor Participant Permission, Release and License Agreement prior to camp attendance.
- Parents are to drop off camper(s) **curbside in the south parking lot (adjacent to the staircase leading directly to the pool deck)**. Please stay in your vehicle. Staff will greet you and your child, take a temperature reading and sign them in. *Carpooling is discouraged.*
- Campers are to arrive wear clothing suitable to water activity. No changing on site.
- Locker rooms are for handwashing and restroom use ONLY.
- Campers are to **bring only a water bottle, hat, and sunglasses (optional if on bungee cord) and coast guard approved life jacket**. If the camper is unable to supply his/her own life jacket, one will be provided. Camp issued life jackets will be disinfected between AM and PM camp sessions.
- Each camper's belongings will be stored on their paddleboard. Nothing is to be left on property. **No towels**. Parents, please bring a towel to pick-up.
- Sunscreen should be applied *before* arriving at camp. Upon entry, campers will be asked to use hand sanitizer.
- Parents, please ensure your camper arrives **wearing a face mask**. Faces masks are required while on property except for during active sport (i.e. On the paddleboard in the lake).
- **Be on time. No late arrivals.** Campers will head out promptly for the duration of camp returning 15 minutes prior to the conclusion.

WHILE AT CAMP

- The paddleboard camp will launch from the beach and return at the conclusion of camp.
- The camper: staff ratio will be 5:1.
- While on the property and lake, counselors will manage campers to be socially distanced.

PICKUP

- Parents/guardians must sign out and pickup camper(s) curbside at the drop off/pickup location. Stay in your vehicle. Your child will be escorted to your car by a staff person. *Carpooling is discouraged.*
- Arrive on-time. A \$5 fee is charged for each 5-minute increment that a parent is late
 - Pickup Time – AM Paddleboard Camp 12:00PM
 - Pickup Time – PM Paddleboard Camp 4:00PM
- Campers should wash their hands thoroughly or use hand sanitizer after leaving camp.
