2020 MIBC SUMMER CAMP GUIDELINES

6.22.2020

BEFORE ARRIVAL & DROP OFF

Protect against infections:

- Stay at home if your child(ren) are sick.
- DO NOT ENTER if your child(ren) has been diagnosed with COVID 19 (have not recovered or are still within the 14 day quarantine), had symptoms of COVID 19 (within the last 24 hours), or had contact with a person that has or is suspected to have COVID 19 (within the last 24hrs).
- Parents/guardians must sign the MIBC Minor Participant Permission, Release and License Agreement prior to camp attendance.
- Parents are to drop off camper(s) curbside at the Clubhouse. Stay in your vehicle. A counselor will greet you and your child, take a temperature reading and sign them in. *Carpooling is discouraged*.
- Campers are asked to bring and wear their own masks while on property except for active sports (i.e. tennis & swimming).
- Campers are asked to wear their swimsuit to minimize changing.
- Please ensure that your child arrives **wearing a face mask** and bring **hand sanitizer, tennis racket, tennis shoes, swimsuit & towel, water bottle and lunch (full day campers)** and any other items they may need (sunscreen etc.). Sunscreen should be applied *before* arriving at camp. Upon entry, campers will be asked to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer.
- Locker rooms are for handwashing and restroom use ONLY.

WHILE AT CAMP

- The camp "home base' is located outside on the Clubhouse deck. From there, groups will engage in activities throughout the property. In the event of rain, "home base" will move inside the Clubhouse.
- Campers will be assigned a "color" group. Groups will strive to meet a 5:1 camper to counselor ratio. Campers will remain with this group and counselor for the week.
- Counselors will design activities that do not need close physical contact.
- Shared materials will be limited.
- Hand washing or the use of hand sanitizer will be promoted throughout the day.
- Counselors will clean and sanitize snack, lunch, and craft spaces before and after use.
- Furniture is disinfected daily by maintenance.
- Counselors will distribute AM and PM snacks using gloves.
- Campers will be afforded time to re-apply sunscreen after strenuous activities. Campers are to provide and apply their own sunscreen. If assistance is required, staff will use gloves.

PICKUP

- Parents/guardians must sign out and pickup camper(s) curbside at the Clubhouse. Stay in your vehicle. Your child will be escorted by a MIBC staff person. *Carpooling is discouraged*.
- A \$5 fee is charged for each 5 minute increment that a parent is late
 - o Pickup Time Half Day 12:30PM
 - o Pickup Time Full Day 4:00PM
- Campers should wash their hands thoroughly or use hand sanitizer after leaving camp.
